# Senior Exams

- Seniors with a 90% or above final average may be exempt from exam. This is at the teachers discretion.
- All exams will be scheduled for one period in length (63 mins).
- All exams will be given during the regularly scheduled period. Exception is C block exam will be first block on Friday, May 30th. Students should not ask teachers to change exam time.
- Seniors who miss an exam will receive a zero for the exam. A doctor's note or other appropriate form of excusal (refer to the student handbook) must be turned in to the main office in order to excuse the absence and take the Make-Up Exam.

# Senior Obligation Forms

- Forms will be handed out in your English class on Wednesday or Thursday of next week.
  - Do not walk around and interrupt class to get forms signed.
- Forms will be turned after rehearsal on Tuesday, June 3rd.
  - If you have a parking pass you will turn it in at that time.
  - If you have not paid for a pass, but we know you drove all year, you will not receive your cap and gown until you pay the parking fee
- You will not receive your cap and gown after graduation rehearsal if your form was not turned in.
