Parking Privileges Agreement

Please read and discuss this agreement with your parent or guardian. Your signature below indicated that you have read and understood the conditions and rules for parking on school grounds. You must return this form signed by both you and your parent or guardian prior to receiving a parking tag.

Bringing a vehicle to school and parking on campus is a privilege granted by the Ashland School Committee. Students are required to agree to certain conditions and to follow certain rules before these privileges are granted. Conditions and rules must be adhered to in order to retain this privilege.

The following must be completed before parking privileges are granted:

- 1. Completion of the "Parking Privileges Agreement" Form (signed by student and parent/guardian).
- 2. Payment of \$100 parking fee (this is an annual fee).
- 3. Submission of copies of your license and registration.

Conditions:

- Students are required to display a parking tag on the rear view mirror. Current bus passes may be placed in the driver side window for temporary parking privileges.
- 2. Current bus passes may be turned in to the high school office in exchange for parking pass should a student no longer be riding the school bus but rather driving to and from school and needing a parking pass.
- 3. Student and parent signatures on the "Parking Privileges Agreement" Form give the Administration permission to search the student's vehicle on school property, if sufficient cause exists for them to believe that a violation of school rules and regulations of this handbook exists.
- 4. Any changes in the status of a student's registered vehicle must be forwarded to the Main Office. Students who fail to comply may have parking privileges revoked.
- 5. Students must comply with all guidelines regarding campus privileges.

Rules:

- 1. Obey posted speed limits not more than 10 mph on campus.
- 2. Park only in student parking areas!
- 3. Do not go to your car during the school day without permission from an administrator.
- 4. You and the owner of the vehicle are responsible for violations, which include violations by anyone you have allowed in your vehicle.
- 5. Parking tags are your responsibility and are to be in your possession only.
- 6. Loss of tag will require a \$50.00 replacement charge.
- 7. Students may not loiter in their vehicles at any time.
- 8. Student drivers must wait for the buses to depart at dismissal prior to leaving the parking lot.
- 9. Students must wear seatbelts, as Massachusetts' law requires for all drivers.

Consequences:

- 1. Verbal warning
- 2. Loss of privileges for 5 days
- 3. Loss of privileges for 10 days
- 4. Possible revocation of privileges for remainder of year

Severe Clause:

1. Immediate and indefinite loss of parking privileges.
